**SCPOA Standing Rule 10-002**

This standing rule is to establish policy regarding minimum training requirements for Range Master's that supervise and/or train firearms using the SCPOA Training Facility.

During any organized shooting event and/or training, a certified Range Master(s) shall supervise the event and/or training at all times. Only certified Range Masters shall be on the firing range during any and all live firing and/or training without exception.

The Board of Directors has adopted the P.O.S.T. Range Master to student ratio as a minimum:

- Maximum of 5 Students to 1 Range Master on static shooting line.
- Maximum of 1 Student to 1 Range Master on a moving shoot.

All California Law Enforcement agency members shall ensure their Range Masters meet the following minimum training:

- 80 hour P.O.S.T. Range Master Training.
- Trained as an instructor for the firearms they are training with.
- Range Masters shall not have more than 3 years absence of training without re-certification with an approved P.O.S.T. range master course.

All Federal Law Enforcement agency members shall ensure their Range Masters meet the minimum training specified by their agency for training firearms.

All Non-Law Enforcement organizations, approved to use the training facility, shall ensure their Range Masters have met the minimum training as specified in All California Law Enforcement agencies. All Non-Law Enforcement agencies shall submit to the Board of Directors the proof of their Range Master(s) training before a range(s) will be scheduled.

All Non-Law Enforcement organizations that do not have P.O.S.T. Law Enforcement trained Range Masters, shall submit to the Board of Directors the proof of Range Master(s) training before a range(s) will be scheduled.

The SCPOA Board of Directors reserves the right to review and verify any Range Master training to ensure the safety of our membership and boarding neighbors.

This standing rule was approved by the majority of the Board of Directors on March 8, 2010.
