SCPOA Standing Rule 10-005

In accordance to provide a safe firearms training environment, the Board of Directors has, by majority vote, agreed to the following requirements of their membership agencies and non-member agencies / organizations using the facility:

- Range master regulations, see Standing Rule #10-002
- Each agency / organization Lead Range master / Program Manager shall review, agree and sign acknowledgment of the training facility rules. See Standing Rule #10-003
- Each agency / organization Lead Range master / Program Manager shall review with each agency / organization Range master(s) the training facility rules.
- Each agency / organization Range master shall ensure the Training Facilities Rules will be followed by their agency members.
- It is the responsibility of each agency / organization Range master to inspect daily the range facilities and impact areas, for any hazards or problems, before use.
- The SCPOA provides a hard line emergency phone on Range 2. Each Range master shall know where it is. Each Range master shall additionally provide additional communications to call for assistance in case of an emergency. Example: Cell phone or two-way radio to SHASCOM.
- Each agency / organization shall provide and have accessible a first aid kit, adequate to handle the control of bleeding and/or gunshot wounds.
- Each Range master shall ensure each member / shooter wear eye and ear protection.
- Each Range master shall ensure each member / shooter wear clothing and footwear appropriate for the course of fire and terrain. For example, Tank tops, low-necked T-shirts, shorts or similar clothing is not recommended. Footwear should completely cover the toes and be suitable for standing and running. Wearing body armor is encouraged.
- Range masters should wear distinctive clothing to identify the Range master / Instructor.
- Range masters are not required to clean up spent brass, but are responsible for the range being cleaned after use, target stands removed from the firing line, targets and damaged target stands disposed of and range trash cans emptied.

This standing rule was approved by the majority of the Board of Directors on April 12, 2010.
