SCPOA Standing Rule 10-009

DVR System

The SCPOA Board of Directors has installed a series of video cameras at the SCPOA Training facility and Clubhouse to ensure the rules of the training facility and clubhouse will be followed, the video will be monitored when necessary.

The SCPOA Board of Directors is concerned when the training facility and/or clubhouse has no signed representative or damage deposit for an event.

The intent of the video cameras is not for criminal or civil proceedings. The video cameras are to insure the range facilities and/or clubhouse rules are followed. The Board of Directors will assign a minimum of two current board members to have access to this system that is password protected. Only current board members can view the recorded system and in no event shall copies of the DVR recorded system be released without the majority board approval.

In the event specific rules are not followed or damage/theft occurs to the facility, the SCPOA Board of Directors will be notified. It will be the decision of the board how the matter shall be handled. When any portion of the facility is represented by a specific member(s), the cameras can be turn off upon request.

This standing rule was approved by the majority of the Board of Directors on October 11, 2010.
