SCPOA Standing Rule 10-010

Red Warning Lights

Each firearm range is equipped with “Red Warning Lights.” These red warning lights are installed in a position where approaching members and/or their guests can be warned the range may have live fire or in use.

These red warning lights assist approaching SCPOA members and/or their guest(s) the range is occupied and live. It also provides adequate time and distance to prepare for any loud noise and utilize equipment to avoid any hearing injury.

It will be the responsibility of the attending agency range-master and/or member using the range to turn on the warning lights during firearm use on that specific range. At the conclusion of the training or use, the range-master and/or SCPOA member shall turn off the red warning light.

In the event the agency range-master and/or SCPOA member fails to activate the warning lights will assume all responsibility of any incident caused by not alerting approaching people.

This standing rule was approved by the majority of the Board of Directors on October 11, 2010.
