SCPOA Firearms Training Program

In California, the law enforcement agencies have been hit hard during the current financial recession. This has forced excessive lay-offs of personnel. In further checking, the some agencies are having financial and manpower issues keeping up with required firearm training. On May 9, 2011, the SCPOA Board of Directors discussed the issues and voted assist by adopting the following training program.

SCPOA Firearms Training program may include classroom, physical qualification and re-qualifications as needed. All training and qualification will be conducted at the SCPOA Record Range Training Facility, 9880 Record Range Road, Redding, CA 96001.

SCPOA Firearms Training program may include the following:

- Training designed to provide in-service officers training, qualifications, as specified by the local law enforcement agencies.
- Training designed to provide retired peace officers firearm qualification and re-qualifications for requirements under HR 218 (carry in 50 states) or California only specified by the retirees agency..
- Training designed to provide private citizens qualification and re-qualifications for concealed firearms in California (California Concealed Weapons Permit / CCW).
- Training designed to provide qualifications and re-qualifications for civilian armed guards.

SCPOA Firearms Training program will vary depending on the specific class.

- Training would consist of lecture / classroom and Lab / range (Live Fire) training, qualification and re-qualification as needed.
- Each course maybe different. For example, each law enforcement agency sets their training and qualification based on state minimum requirements. Some expand from the minimum standards.
- Requirements for Retired Peace Officer in California / HR 218 are different and not defined. Each law enforcement agency sets the requirements.
- Requirements for civilian CCW permits are 10-12 hours. for first time certification. Required re-qualification is 4 hours of training.

- Requirements for civilian armed guard are set by California Bureau Security and Investigative Services (BSIS). Required training is 12 hours.

SCPOA Firearms Training program will adhere to all SCPOA By Laws and Standing Rules. Specifically:

- By Law Standing Rule 10-002. Minimum training requirements for Range Masters and instructor to student ratio.
- By Law Standing Rule 10-003. Range Rules.
- By Law Standing Rule 10-005. Safe firearm training environment.
- By Law Standing Rule 10-010. Red light range warning.

SCPOA Board of Directors will assign a board member to supervise the training program. This assignment has no specific term of office and serves at the will of the Board of Directors.

SCPOA and/or any contracted Range Master will possess all local, state and federal certification, licenses and/or permits as maybe required.

SCPOA provides insurance to all Range Masters, instructors and/or students during the hours of training.

SCPOA will provide a safe firearms range. Included with a safe range, the SCPOA will provide a telephone (Land Line) at Range 2. In addition, the SCPOA will provide a trauma kit to be used for any first aid incident. For any incident requiring more than first aid, the Range Master and/or Instructor shall call 911 for emergency response. No Range Master and/or Instructor shall transport an injured person to a treating facility.

SCPOA Board of Directors has planned to start this training on or before July 1, 2011.

SCPOA Board of Directors shall set all training fees. Any discount, exemption, grants or scholarships offered, instead of training fees, will be decided by the current Board of Directors. The intent of any fee charged is to cover instructor and range costs.

SCPOA Board of Directors will encourage public donations and /or grants to assist in providing a safe firearms range.

All students will have full use of assigned facilities under the direct supervision of the Range Master and/or instructors.

This standing rule was approved by the majority of the Board of Directors on July 1, 2011
